PHEAA State Grant

- An on-line application must be submitted to PHEAA at www.pheaa.org
- If you receive a summer 2009 state grant, it could affect your state grant eligibility in future semesters
- State grant eligibility is only available for up to 8 full-time semesters; typically, **the students who apply for summer consideration are those who plan to accelerate their degree program and graduate in less than four years**
- It is recommended that students apply no later than May 31
- Deadline for applications is August 15th
- Eligibility is typically determined by PHEAA in mid-summer; however, PHEAA will not send the funds to SRU until August/September
- Students must meet the PHEAA academic progress requirements to be eligible
- The PHEAA State Grant may cause a decrease in loan eligibility

Federal Pell Grant

- Students are automatically considered for the Federal Pell Grant if a FAFSA is on file
- Students should file the 2009-2010 FAFSA for Federal Pell Grant consideration
- Funds may not be available until mid-summer

Other State Grants

- Students should contact their state's grant agency for more information

Billing and Refunds

- **The Office of Student Accounts cannot refund excess aid until a student has actually attended six credits**

Summer Eligibility Requirements:

* Undergraduate students must be enrolled in 6 credits at SRU during the summer to be eligible for loans

* Graduate students must be taking 6 graduate credits. If a student's enrollment drops below 6 credits, all Federal loan funds will be returned to the lender

* Students are expected to meet academic progress requirements for federal financial aid eligibility. For more information:

* Loan approvals may take 4-6 weeks during the summer

Federal Stafford Loan

- You must complete the Summer 2009 Financial Aid Form
- The Summer 2009 Financial Aid Form must be submitted and processed by the SRU Financial Aid Office prior to the student's last day of summer enrollment
- If you have never received a Stafford Loan in the past, contact the SRU Financial Aid Office to complete additional required paperwork
- If a Stafford Loan was borrowed during fall '08 and/or spring '09, eligibility may be limited
- When the loan arrives at SRU, it will be credited directly to the student's account
- **Many students may not have Stafford Loan eligibility remaining for summer. You will be notified in writing of your eligibility or ineligibility.** NOTE for December 2009 graduates: The amount that you borrow in the summer may lower your fall loan eligibility
- Loan funds will be directly credited to the student's account
- We recommend that you begin the summer loan process in early April

Federal PLUS Loan

- Allows parents and graduate students to borrow additional funds for the student's expenses
- If the parent or graduate student has previously borrowed a PLUS loan through AES: Contact AES (1-800-692-7392) or apply online (www.aesSuccess.org). If you use a different guarantor, call the guarantor for assistance
- If the parent or graduate student has not previously borrowed: Contact the SRU Financial Aid Office
- Loan funds will be directly credited to the student's account
- We recommend that you begin the summer loan process in early April

Work Study

- Federal Work Study is available to students who show financial need after all other financial aid is awarded
 - Information can be acquired at the Career Services website (www.sru.edu/pages/10850.asp)
 - Students are paid minimum wage and bi-weekly based upon number of hours worked
 - Checks are issued directly to the student, and are not credited toward their SRU account
- Requirements:**
- Returning students must have enrolled for at least 6 credits during spring 2009, and be registered for at least 6 credits for fall 2009
 - Incoming freshmen, transfer, or graduate students must have been offered and accepted admission for fall 2009
 - Students who will graduate in summer 2009, must be registered for at least 6 credits

Graduate Assistantships

VA Benefits
