

**Slippery Rock University
Student Right-to-Know Act
Graduation Rate Report**

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, Slippery Rock University is pleased to share with you the following information on the graduation rates of our (Fall, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002) cohort of full-time, first-time, degree or certificate seeking undergraduates and student athletes who received athletic financial aid.

While reviewing this information, please keep the following in mind:

- All graduation rates are based upon six years of attendance which equates 150% of the normal completion time of our longest program.
- In accordance with the Student Right-to-Know regulations, we have elected not to report transfer-out rates because our university's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in another eligible institution without completing or graduating.
- These charts do not identify the reasons why our students withdrew; therefore, students who withdrew for personal or medical reasons are included.
- Graduation rates do not include students who left school to serve in the armed forces or on official church missions or with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were totally and permanently disabled.
- To assure the rights of privacy of our students, a pound sign (#) denotes any cohort/subcohort category with five or fewer students. The university is not required to disclose this information.
